Reinvestment Progress Update (Thru Nov.)

To date, the FNB Financial Center project has made contract commitments to **74** M/WBEs across Construction and Pre-Development

- \$36.3M in contracts to Minority-Owned Businesses (33%)
- \$24.7M to Black-Owned Businesses (24%)
- \$8.5M to Women-Owned Businesses (8%)
- Construction commitments to 42 MWBEs ranging from \$15k to \$7.4M
- Construction on the FNB Financial Center is approx. 26% complete and minorities have accounted for 25% of the onsite labor

Total Subcontract awards \$107,980,101.00



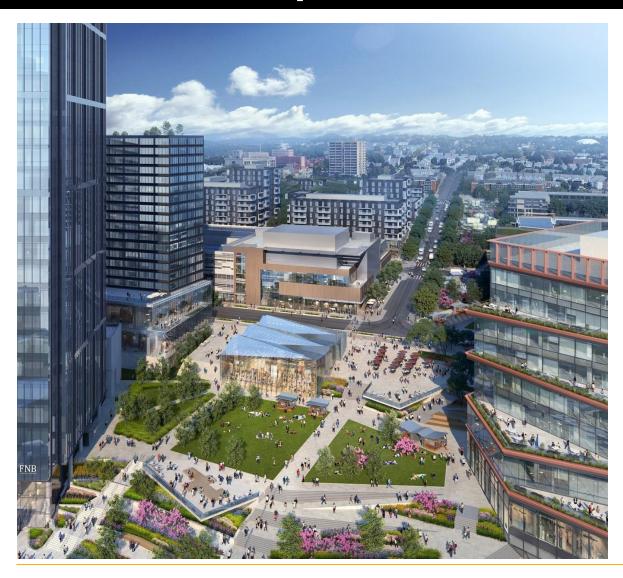

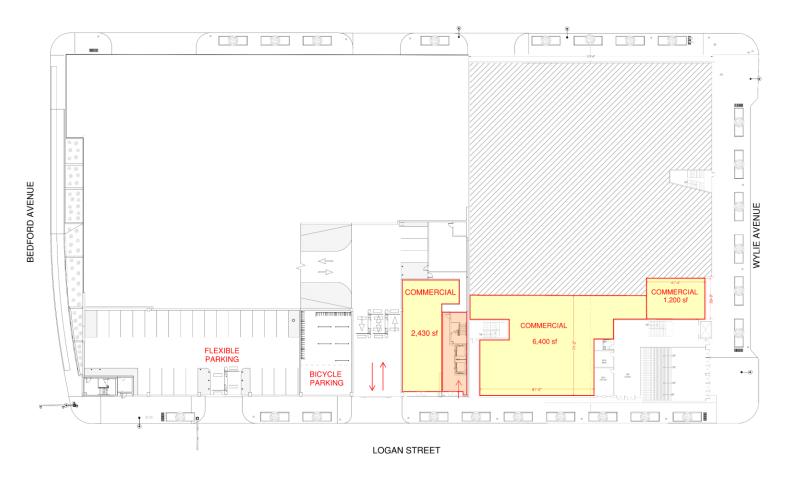

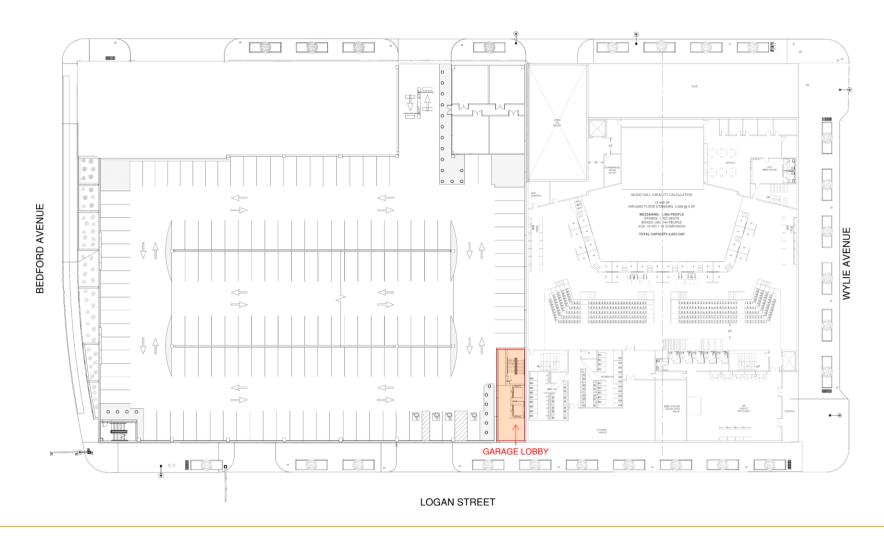
Block E Development – Street Level Plan

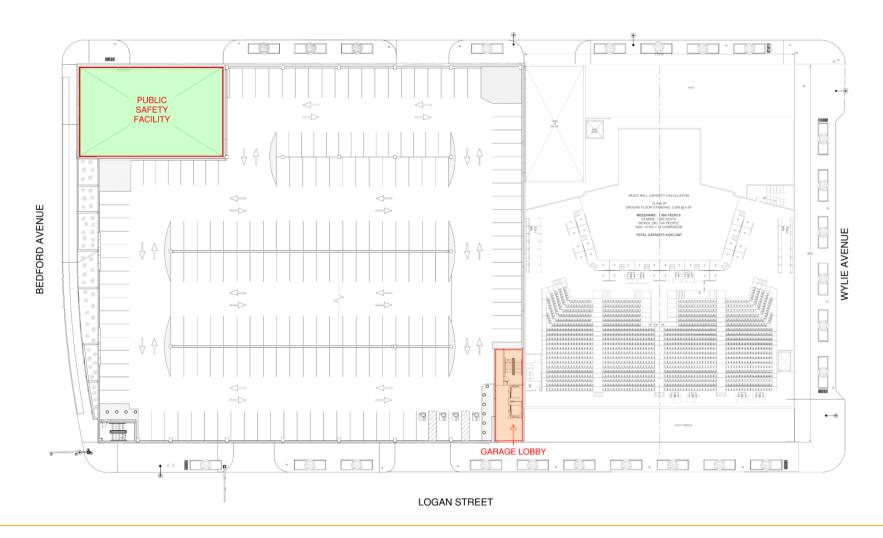
Third Floor Plan
