

## OAC MAJOR GOALS

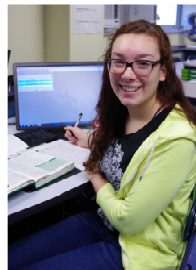
The Occupational Advisory Committee has several major goals:
